Rules

- Limited to 25 teams
- 3-person teams
- One team member must be 16 years old or over
- Minimum age to participate is 5 years old
- One or two team members must ride on the boat
- All riders must wear life vests (*you furnish*)
- Can use only the materials supplied (*other supplies will be disqualified*)
- Surf boards or items like surf boards don't qualify as 'boats'
- Must travel prepared course, approximately 30 yards
- Boats may be propelled by one paddle (*you furnish*) or paddles made from materials provided, crew arms & legs
- Crews must remain in boat during the race - no towing, swimming or using life preservers for flotation of vessel
- No throwing water on other boats (*except for accidental splashing*)
- Crews are expected to be courteous & respectful
- Judges will interpret rules, their decision is final

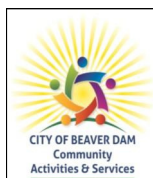
